S.O.L. REQUIREMENTS
How our garden program relates.

MATH:

- Kindergarten K-10... Students will identify instruments used to measure temperature.
Example: The weather station.
- First Grade 1.19... Students will interpret information using vocabulary: more, fewer, greater than and less than.
Example: Our petting farm has more chickens than pigs
- Second Grade 2.22... Seeing a calendar, students will identify specific dates.
Example: Planting of seeds to germinate.

SCIENCE:

- Kindergarten K-6... Students will investigate and understand basic needs and life processes of plants and animals.
- First Grade 1.4... Students will investigate and understand plant life needs.
Example: Plants need food, air, water, light and a place to grow.
- Second Grade 2.8... Investigate that plants produce oxygen and food and provide benefits to nature.
Example: Greenhouse and garden vegetables

ENGLISH:

- Kindergarten K-2... Students will use listening skills and speaking vocabularies.
Example: Follow one and two step directions.
- First Grade 1.7... Students will use meaning clues when reading.
Example: Use of pictures in our greenhouse.
- Second Grade 2.2... Follow oral directions with three or four steps.
Example: How each child will plant seedlings in our garden.
