Hunt Club Farm is now accepting reservations for our **22nd annual "Children's Garden Program!"** This year's field trip will be offered on weekdays from April 4th to June 30th.

Our gardening program was designed to provide students with a better understanding of plants and animals through "hands-on" learning. Our educational field trips strive to incorporate experiences that reinforce Virginia's Science, English and Math SOL guidelines for Pre-K through 3rd grade. 2016's field trips will have a limited number of daily attendees in order to focus on small groups to enhance the total garden experience.

Your class's one-hour guided tour includes the following learning stations:

- *Life Cycles & Butterfly Garden*
- *Bee's Buzz (observational beehive)*
- *Bull Frog Pond- Tadpoles & Frogs*
- *Birds recycle so can you!*
- *Planting Experience- What plants need to grow?*
- *Where's the worm?*

Points of discussion:

- *Benefits of Plants & Animals to our Environment*
- *Different Habitats and Camouflage for Animals*
- *How Seeds Travel*



At the conclusion of your tour, our picnic area is available for lunch or snack. You and your students may stay in the petting farm as long as you would like as well. Additionally, we will provide all guests with a colorful gift to make your trip complete. Reservations must be made in advance. The cost is \$7 per child and there is *no charge* for teachers.
