Hunt Club Farm is now accepting reservations for our **24th annual "Children's Garden Program!"** This year's field trip will be offered on weekdays from April 2nd to June 8th 2018.

Our gardening program was designed to provide students with a better understanding of plants and animals through "hands-on" learning. Our educational field trip strives to incorporate experiences that reinforce Virginia's Science, English, and Math SOL guidelines for Pre-K through 3rd grade. 2018's field trips will have a limited number of daily attendees in order to focus on small groups to enhance the total garden experience.

Your class's one-hour guided tour includes the following learning stations:

- *Bee's Buzz (observational beehive)*
- *Bull Frog Pond – Lifecycle*
- *Aviary Adventure – Feeding experience*
- *Planting Experience*
- *Where's the worm? Digging for worms*

Points of discussion:

- *Benefits of Plants & Animals to our Environment*
- *Different Habitats and Camouflage for Animals*
- *How Seeds Travel*

At the conclusion of your tour, our picnic area is available for lunch or snack. You and your students may stay in the petting farm as long as you would like. Additionally, we will provide all guests with a colorful gift to make your trip complete. Reservations must be made in advance. The cost is \$7 per child and there is *no charge* for teachers or bus drivers. Parents, chaperones, and siblings are required to pay \$7 each to attend this field trip.
